Observational Science

It cannot prove evolution.

It has confirmed the Bible's history.

- 1. There is a huge difference between observational science and historical science:
 - a. <u>Observational</u> Observe something and experiment to draw conclusions.
 - b. <u>Historical</u> Consider things that happened in the past, *but we* cannot observe them or do experiments to draw conclusions.
- 2. The Eifel Tower example: We can observe its size, but we need to look at and believe historical documents to know who designed it and why.
- 3. <u>The Earth example</u>: We can observe that it exists, but how can we know how it came into existence? We have to use *historical* science:
 - a. Was someone there? Y N
 - b. Did He tell someone what happened? Y N
 - c. Did that someone write down what happened? Y N
 - d. What book contains the account of how the Earth came into existence?
 - e. Has that book been proven to be fully reliable? Y N
 - f. These are things we can gain from observational science:
 - The earth is logical and orderly (such things could

- not result from a random big bang).
- ii. The Creator gave the creatures the ability to observe what He created.
- iii. The universe consistently obeys the same laws dayafter-day.

Science is possible only because God exists!

- f. Why are dogs slightly different than their parents? (chose one)

- g. Does adaptation and natural selection give us some understanding about the formation of various species? Y N

h. Does a *loss of information* and redistribution of information support or undermine evolution?

 Since we now have a better understanding of where the various species came from, did Noah need to have all the various species on the ark? Y N

7. Where did Cain get his wife? (Watch: 25:35 – 28:18)

- a. What does the Bible tell us about Adam & Eve's children? They had Cain, Abel, and Seth, but they also had other sons and daughters:
 - i. NAS 1 Corinthians 15:45
 ... "The first man, Adam, became a living soul."
 - ii. NAS Genesis 3:20 "Now the man called his wife's name Eve, because she was the mother of all the living."
 - iii. NAS Acts 17:26 "and He made from one, every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth..."
 - iv. NAS Genesis 5:4 "...Adam... had other sons and daughters."
- b. Cain married one of his sisters.
 - i. The Bible says: NAS Deut. 27:22 "Cursed is he who lies with his sister, the daughter of his father or of his mother." Was it right or wrong for Cain to marry his sister?

- 8. How did the different "races" of people come about? (Watch: 28:19 32:40)
 - a. Are there multiple races of people or one race?

NAS Acts 17:26 "...He made from one [person], every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth..."

- b. Think about some key parts of the Biblical timeline:
 - i. God created Adam: NAS Genesis 2:7 Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being."
 - ii. From Adam God created
 Eve: NAS Genesis 2:21-22

 "So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and he slept; then He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh at that place. And the LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man."
 - iii. From Adam and Eve came all people:
 - 1. NAS Genesis 1:28 And God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth...
 - 2. Genesis 2 tells *the details* of Genesis 1.
 - iv. 1,600 years later God reduced the world population to eight with the global flood: NAS Gen.
 7:7 Then Noah and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him entered the

- ark because of the water of the flood.
- v. Now all people regardless of skin color, language, culture, etc. are descendants of Noah and his family.
- vi. Those people were given various languages and scattered over the whole earth through the Tower of Babel event (Genesis 11:1-19).
- vii. All colors of people came from Noah's family, just like all dogs came from wolves.
- c. Think about the big *spiritual* picture:
 - i. Adam and Eve sinned:
 - NAS **Genesis 3:1** Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Indeed, has God said, 'You shall not eat from any tree of the garden'?" ² And the woman said to the serpent, "From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat; 3 but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat from it or touch it, lest you die.'" ⁴ And the serpent said to the woman, "You surely shall not die! 5 For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6 When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was

desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate.

- ii. God promised the Savior:

 NAS Genesis 3:15 "And I will
 put enmity Between you
 and the woman, And
 between your seed and her
 seed; He shall bruise you on
 the head, And you shall
 bruise him on the heel."
- iii. Sin spread to all people:

 NAS Genesis 4:8 ...Cain rose
 up against Abel his brother
 and killed him.... 5:3 When
 Adam had lived one
 hundred and thirty years,
 he became the father of a
 son in his own likeness,
 according to his image, and
 named him Seth.
- iv. The Savior came, lived, died, rose, and ascended: NAS 1 Corinthians 15:1-5 Now I make known to you, brethren, the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve.

v. All who receive the Savior are forgiven and restored to God's family: NAS John 1:12-13 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God."

- 13. Why does it matter what Christians

 believe about Genesis? (Watch: 55:38 –
 57:25) When we believe the Bible is God's

 Word of Truth, we know the following
 foundational information from Genesis
 chapters 1-11:
 - a. God Created (chap. 1-2); evolution is false and encourages people to reject the Bible, God, sin, and Jesus.
 - b. **First Marriage** (chap. 2); God brought the woman to the man; same sex marriage is an abomination to God.
 - Fall into Sin (chap. 3); the people brought sin and death into the world, not God.
 - d. **Promise of the Savior** (chap. 3); on the day they fell into sin, God promised to send a special descendant of the woman who would defeat Satan.
 - e. **Clothes** (chap. 3); through the first blood sacrifice, God made clothes for Adam and Eve, and pointed to the ultimate blood sacrifice of the Christ to cover our sins.
 - f. **First Murder** (chap. 4); Cain murdered Abel, who was eventually replaced with Seth (Luke 3:38).
 - g. The Time from Adam to the Flood (chap. 5); the first genealogy list, which totals 1656 years.
 - h. Decline into Much Evil (chap. 6);
 believers married unbelievers,
 which sped up the decline into evil.
 - Worldwide Flood (chap. 6-9); the LORD's Preliminary Judgment on Evil, which points ahead to the final judgment.
 - j. Nations Descended from Noah (chap. 10); the ones who repopulated the earth.

- k. Languages of the World (chap. 11); the tower of Babel event divided the people into 90-some language groups and caused them to disperse and fill the earth.
- I. The Time from the Flood to the Birth of Abram (chap. 11); the second genealogy list, which totals 290 years.
