These are some key Bible verses:

- Isaiah 40:8 The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever.
- Psalm 119:160 The sum of Your word is truth...
- 2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is inspired by God...
- 2 Peter 1:21 for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

This is how we interpret the Bible:

- We use the Historical-Grammatical method. To explain that in simple terms, we take the Bible to mean what it says. For example, the Bible says, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" (Gen. 1:1). So, we believe God created the heavens and the earth.
- We use Scripture to interpret Scripture. Much of the Bible is easy to understand; however, when a passage is difficult to understand, we use other passages on that same topic / doctrine to help us understand the one that is difficult. By using that method, God tells us the proper meaning.


Our Grief Share Program
