Advent Series: Come, Lord Jesus – Part 1

Come to Us through the Word

Wednesday, 12/4 at 11:00 & 7:00

Advent Wednesdays: Services at 11 & 7; Meals at 12 & 6

Introduction: Dear Bethlehem – and others who might hear or read: This sermon is meant ◆for me, ◆for you, and ◆for everyone else as well. It is meant to ✓ catch our attention, ✓ teach us some important realities, and ✓ challenge our current practices and priorities!

In this sermon, I will ➡touch on the Parable of the sower,
➡mention some of what God does through His Word, and
➡give some Word-usage advice.

- The Parable of the Sower: Earlier I read Jesus' story (Matthew 13:3-9, 18-23) – how the man went out to sow seed, and how, in three of the four examples, the seed fell in places where it ⊗did not grow or ⊗did not continue to grow. Then Jesus explained the story.
 - a. Let's think about it:
 - i. What does the seed represent? It represents THE WORD OF GOD!
 - What do the four places represent? By the road, bin the shallow soil, bamong the thorns, and bin the good soil; what do those four places represent? They represent THE HEARTS OF VARIOUS PEOPLE WHO HEAR THE WORD OF GOD!

- b. <u>Something very significant</u>: Let me explain:
 - If you are hearing this sermon at Bethlehem: You are included in the parable, and have a 25% chance of benefitting from the Word of God. <u>Why</u>? Remember Jesus' story: ALL HEARD the Word of God, but only 1 of 4 benefitted!
 - ii. If you are listening to this sermon through our website or podcast, or reading a printed copy: You are also included in the parable, and have a 25% chance of benefitting from the Word of God.
 - iii. The others: What about the people who never hear or read the Bible in a serious way? Their chance of benefitting is 0%.
- c. <u>However, there is still good news</u>: <u>Why</u>?
 Because ★God still loves us, ★Jesus has taken away the sin of the world, and ★we have many opportunities to benefit from God's Holy Word!
- What God Does Through His Word: When we are in the Word of God in a serious way, God the Father through the Holy Spirit gives these blessings:
 - a. Makes spiritually alive: ^{NIV} James 1:18 [God] chose to give us [spiritual] birth through the word of truth... // As God gives physical life through a man and a woman, so God gives spiritual life through His Word!
 - b. Sets free from condemnation: NAS John 8:32 [Jesus said:] ...you shall know the truth, and the

truth shall make you free. // Are you *free through God's truth or *wearing eternal chains? The answer is **not** *in how we feel*, **but** *in what God's Word says*, so let us dig it and find out!

- c. Builds up and gives eternal blessings: ^{ESV} Acts 20:32 [Paul to the Pastors serving in Ephesus:] ... I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. // God wants to *move us from weak to strong and *bless us forever! He does that important and blessed work through His Word!
- 3. Some Word-Usage Advice: Be aware that many powerful forces will seek to stop us from using from God's Word. Jesus, *in His story*, identified: The devil, our sinful hearts, and the fallen world. When we don't feel like being in God's Word, *we can be sure that one or more of those powerful forces are at work!* But God is greater, so I challenge all of us to consistently receive the Word of God in ALL of these ways:
 - a. Divine Service at least once each week, twice each week during Advent and Lent! Why? God works through Word and Sacrament ✓ to remind us who we are in Christ, ✓ remind us of our sins, ✓ call us to be sorry, ✓ assure us of His forgiveness, ✓ strengthen us in Christ, and ✓ equip us for works of service. Are those the reasons why you attend? Right now we have 4 opportunities each week, so plan on SA or SU, and 11 or 7 on WE; also, expect resistance, but remember that God is greater!

- b. Bible Class at least once each week: Why? The Bible is our sword the sword of the Spirit! We need that sword because of our enemies: ☺The devil—who wants to eat us for breakfast, ☺the sinful world around us, and ☺the sinful nature within us. Imagine being in a sword fight... your opponent has a sharp 30-inch sword, while you have dull 6-inch sword... NOT GOOD! Therefore, plan to attend on TH at 10 at BLC or online, SA at 3, or SU at 10:30. God WILL bless you!
- c. Daily Devotion at least once each day: We have many options the Bible, Portals along with the noted Bible readings, Meditations, Advent Devotional, A Closer Look at the Evidence, etc. Whenever we are in God's Word, It is vital to ◆think, ◆understand, and ◆apply; watch for more next week on those topics. BTW, without daily devotion in my life, 😕I would not be in Christ, 의 I would not be a pastor, and 😕I would be facing a horrible eternity!

Conclusion: Blessings or excuses – going forward, which will <u>dominate your life</u>? *Today is an excellent time to take the first step in a NEW DIRECTION!* If you are determined to do so, *be sure to join us next Wednesday as we pray*: Come Lord Jesus, Come to Us to Change Our Hearts!!
