Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: With the help, guidance, and strength of the Almighty God, we have made it through 2020! Now what? Right now, THINGS are not much different than last year, yet **WE** can be different!

## We all have choices:

- (3) We can allow our circumstances to control us, OR
- We can choose to go forward in the all the best ways regardless of our circumstances!

Today's Bible text focuses on a key time in Jesus' life as He transitioned **from** being a boy **to** becoming an adult. For us, today is a key time as we make our plans for **2021**.

1. Jesus' Early Years (0-12): God in human flesh was → born and visited by shepherds (Luke 2:1-20); then → named Jesus and circumcised when eight days old (Luke 2:21); then → at

the temple when 40 days old (Luke 2:22-38); then ⇒back to Bethlehem and visited by the wise men (Matt. 2:1-12); then ⇒in Egypt for a short time to avoid Herod's murderous soldiers (Matt. 2:13-18); then, after Herod's death, ⇒settled in Nazareth (Matt. 2:19-23). Now, as we get into today's sermon text, keep in mind that this is the ONLY Bible passage containing a specific event about Jesus between the time He was an infant and an adult! It would be nice to know more, but that information is NOT essential for our salvation! This verse summarizes the next 11 years of Jesus' life: <sup>40</sup> The Child [Jesus] continued to grow and become strong, increasing in wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him. // Jesus had God-fearing and believing parents who taught Him the Scriptures and so much more! Let us also teach all who are willing!!

- 2. Jesus at 12 Years Old: Jesus at the age of 12 transitioned from a boy to a man.
  - a. He attended the Passover in Jerusalem: <sup>41</sup> Now His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. <sup>142</sup> And when He became twelve, they went up there according to the custom of the Feast; <sup>43</sup> and as they were returning, after spending the full number of days [that is, 8 days], the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. But His parents were unaware of it, <sup>44</sup> but supposed Him to be in the caravan [among relatives or friends], and went a day's journey [one of at least 4 days to travel the 90 miles]; and they began looking for Him among their relatives and acquaintances.
  - b. <u>His parents looked for Him</u>: <sup>45</sup> When they did not find Him [among the caravan], they returned to Jerusalem

looking for Him. <sup>46</sup> Then, after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions ["...the rabbis often responded to people's questions by posing their own questions" (TLSB); Jesus did the same by asking His own questions]. <sup>47</sup> And all who heard Him were amazed at His understanding and His answers.

- c. He was scolded by His mother: 48 When they saw Him, they were astonished; and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You treated us this way? Behold, Your father and I have been anxiously looking for You [note: that is the last reference in the Bible to Joseph, Jesus' legal father; he must have died between Jesus being 12 and 30]."
- d. He responded to His mother: <sup>49</sup> And He said to them [note: these are the first words of Jesus recorded in the Bible], "Why is it that you were looking for Me? Did you not know that I had to be in My Father's house [that is, the house of my actual Father]?" <sup>50</sup> But they did not understand the statement which He had made to them. // Why? Did Jesus grow up like other boys? Did they forget about Him being Immanuel (God with us)?
- 3. Jesus' Later Years (12-30): <sup>51</sup> And He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and He continued in subjection to them [to obey them]; and His mother treasured all these things in her heart. <sup>52</sup> And Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men. // As He grew like us, <u>let us grow to be like Him!</u>
- 4. Our 2021 Goals: It's good to plan the work; then work the plan! Therefore, let's all identify some 2021 goals: See the insert in today's folder (or download it here > click). Now, let's begin to complete it!
