Green – Growing Up in Jesus

*sent His Son to shed His blood for us and *given us faith by which we trust in Jesus for eternal life. Now, because we have eternal life through Jesus, we grow in Jesus and live for Jesus!

- Colossians 2:6-7 "...as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk [live] in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith..."
- → 2 Corinthians 5:15 "[Jesus] died for all, that they who live [spiritually and eternally, through Jesus] should no longer live for themselves, but for [Jesus] who died and rose again on their behalf."
- ⇒ Galatians 2:20 "I [Paul] have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me."
- → Psalm 119:105 Your word [the Bible] is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path." // Pray, read, and believe; God will bless you!

Gold – Rich Now and Forever

Because of *God's love, *His work through Jesus, and *our God-given faith in Jesus, we are so richly blessed:

- ⇒ All our sins are forgiven!

Introduction

Dear Friend: I hope you will learn more about the *five colors of the Christian Service Medal* by reading this brochure. Then *receive your own medal, *wear it in public, and *let God use you to be an eternal blessing to others as you explain what it means!

Black - The Darkness of Sin

When a room is completely dark, we cannot see. In a similar way, all who do not trust in Jesus for eternal life are in **spiritual darkness**; they are unaware that they are lost (1 Cor. 2:14; Eph. 2:1; Rom. 8:7) and have no ability to escape their sad situation (Jn. 6:44, 65).

- → 2 Corinthians 4:4 "...the god of this world [that is, Satan] has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light [that is, the saving truth] of the gospel..."
- → John 3:19 "...men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil."
- → Proverbs 4:19 "The way of the wicked is like darkness; They do not know over what they stumble."
- Saiah 9:2 "The people who walk in [spiritual] darkness Will see a great light [which points to the coming of Jesus] ..."

For all who are lost in the darkness of sin: *finish reading this brochure, *thoughtfully read in the Bible every day, *faithfully attend a church that teaches the Bible, and *learn how to be certain of heaven through Jesus.

Red – The Blood of Jesus

The color of red can remind us of a heart: God loves us (John 3:16), so He sent His Son to take away the sin of the world (John 1:29). First, Jesus lived a sinless life in our place; second, He shed His blood to take away our sins.

- → Matthew 26:28 "...this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins."
- → 1 John 1:7 "...the blood of Jesus... cleanses us from all sin."
- ➡ Ephesians 2:13 "...you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ."

No one is too sinful; Jesus' blood is powerful to cleanse us from every sin!

The Cross Connection Between the Red Color and the White Color:



When people were lost in spiritual darkness, God the Father sent His Son to freely offer to everyone His great gifts of *light, *truth, *forgiveness, and *eternal life! Keep reading to learn more about Jesus' saving work!

White - The Washing of Sin

The color of white can remind us of a brilliant light. God's light of truth

- →makes us aware of the darkness,
- ♦shows us our need for forgiveness,
- →makes us sorry for our sins, and
- *gives us God's forgiveness through faith in Jesus (we trust in Him for our entrance into heaven)!
 - → John 8:12 "...Jesus... spoke to them, saying, 'I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life.'"
 - John 12:46 "I have come as Light into the world, so that everyone who believes in Me will not remain in darkness."
 - Mark 1:15 "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent [be sorry for your sins] and believe in the gospel [that is, the good news of who Jesus is and His work to take away the sin of the world]."
 - John 5:24 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life."
