In YOUR LIFE

What Is MORE IMPORTANT Than the Kingdom of Heaven?

Text: Matthew 13:44-52 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: To me, my right arm is MORE IMPORTANT than my mobile phone and knowing Jesus is MORE IMPORTANT than my house.

- What is MOST IMPORTANT to you?... Do you have your answer?
- Remember, our actions speak louder than our words! So, do your actions support your answer?
- If *knowing and *living for Jesus are not number 1 in our words and deeds, let us repent today!

<u>Last week</u> we heard Jesus' parable of the **real wheat** and the **fake wheat** (Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43).

<u>Today</u>, we continue in <u>Matthew chapter 13</u> as Jesus tells three more parables about the kingdom of heaven.

1. The GREAT TREASURE Is Kingdom Membership:

44 "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure [something of extreme value] hidden [or concealed] in the field

[somewhere in the world (see v. 38)], which a man found and hid again; and from joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

- a. <u>Country Club Membership</u>: Do you want to be a member of the *New Orleans Country Club*? Okay, the initiation fee is about **100k**, while the annual membership is more than **10k**. If being a member is extremely important to you, then you will do whatever is necessary to pay the price!
- b. <u>Kingdom of Heaven Membership</u>: If being with God forever is MOST IMPORTANT to you, then you are willing to give up everything! Jesus said: "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it" (Mk. 8:35). To give up everything includes our *possessions and *life.
- 2. The GREAT PEARL Is Kingdom Membership: 45 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls, 46 and upon finding one pearl of great value, he went and sold all that he had and bought it. // Let's understand the VALUE of kingdom membership by setting out a *brief* comparison:

Relationship with God | Separation from God | Alive in Christ | Dead in Sin | Living in peace | Living in fear

Eternal bliss Eternal torment

When we know and believe the differences, then we are willing to give up EVERYTHING for membership in the kingdom of heaven!

3. The GOOD FISH Are Kingdom Members:

- a. The Parable Itself: ⁴⁷ "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet [with floats on the top and weights on the bottom] cast into the sea, and gathering fish of every kind; ⁴⁸ and when it was filled, they drew it up on the beach; and they sat down and gathered the good fish into containers, but the bad they threw away.
 - i. <u>The filling</u>: As time marches on in this fallen world, a dragnet is gathering up all kinds of people. When the dragnet is full, that will be the end of the age, the return of Jesus!
 - ii. The separating: When Jesus comes, the separating will take place: "...there will be two men in the field; one will be taken and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken and one will be left" (Matt. 24:40-41).
 - iii. Who are the good fish? All have sinned, so what makes the difference? By the love and choosing and power of God, some unrepentant sinners have been changed into repentant sinners, that is, good fish.
- b. The Parable Explained: ⁴⁹ "So it will be at the end of the age; the angels will come forth and take out the wicked [doers of evil] from among the righteous, ⁵⁰ and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. // Who are the wicked ones? All who do not know Jesus:

- i. The fake wheat from last week either by choice or by deception.
- ii. The ones with mixed up priorities:
 - 1. *Rejecting* the hidden treasure and *keeping* their temporal possessions.
 - 2. *Rejecting* the great pearl and *keeping* their temporal possessions.
- iii. The bad fish by choice or by deception.
- 4. Chapter Summary: Earlier in the chapter (v. 36), Jesus' disciples asked Him to explain a parable. So here, Jesus said to them: ⁵¹ "Have you understood all these things?" They said to Him, "Yes." ⁵² And Jesus said to them, "Therefore every scribe [person skilled in Jewish law and theology] who has become a disciple of the kingdom of heaven is like a head of a household [family], who brings out of his treasure [the things that are of extreme value to him] things new and old." // As disciples of Jesus, we are *learning from Him and *following Him. We have old things that we have known for quite a while, and new things that we have recently learned. Let us *treasure them all and *share them with anyone who is willing to listen!

Let Us Pray: Dear HS, please keep working in our minds and hearts so that our membership in the kingdom of heaven is always the MOST IMPORTANT; then use us to be an eternal blessing to others!
