# SERMON NOTES & BIBLE TEXTS

Once again, you have a <u>special insert</u> in your bulletin that contains <u>sermon</u> <u>notes</u>, as well as three super <u>Bible texts</u> from the Gospel of *Mark*.

For brevity of time, we follow them *closely*.

Today, we treat Lessons 23-25 in your booklet, entitled "The Holy Week Journey." This moves us to the 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> events of Passion Week!

Our <u>three texts</u> deal with (1) our **Savior**'s **preparation** for His last Passover meal, (2) His conversation at that Passover meal, especially concerning His imminent betrayal by Judas, and (3) **Christ**'s **Institution** of the Lord's Supper.

We start with Mark 14:12-16:

#### March 13, 2024—11am & 7pm

## Day 23–Preparing the Passover Meal:

14:12 On the first day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover *lamb* was being sacrificed [on Thursday afternoon of Holy Week], the disciples [of Jesus] said to Him, "Where do You want us to go and <u>prepare</u> for You to eat the Passover?" 13 And He sent two of His disciples and said to them, "Go into the city, and a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him;
14 and wherever he enters, say to the <u>owner</u> of the house, 'The Teacher says, "Where is My guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"
15 And he himself will show you a <u>large</u> upper room furnished *and* ready; prepare for us there."

**16** The disciples went out <u>and came to the city</u>, and found *it* just as He had told [predicted it to] them; and <u>they prepared the Passover</u>. **(Note:** The Passover lamb was killed at the Jerusalem Temple.)

Let's thoroughly examine this Biblical text of Mark.

John Mark's father offered his guestroom. Mark would know all about it (cp. Acts 12:12). **Spiritual question:** What are you offering to Jesus? Let's *continue* with <u>praise</u>, <u>thanksgiving</u>, and <u>service</u> to **GOD**!

We now move to our 2<sup>nd</sup> text from Mark 14:17-21. Join me on page 2:

## Day 24–Eating the Passover Meal:

14:17 When it was evening [near the time of sunset], Jesus came with the Twelve. 18 As they were reclining at the table and eating, Jesus said, "Truly I say to you that one of you will betray Me—one who is eating with Me."
19 They began to be grieved and to say to Him one by one, "Surely not I?"
20 And He said to them, "It is one of [you] Twelve, one who dips with Me in the bowl. 21 For the Son of Man is to go [to be betrayed], just as it is written of Him; but woe to that man [namely, Judas] by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been better for that man if he had never been born."

We now explain these words of Jesus!

**Final thought: GOD** did not cause Judas to betray **Jesus**; **Satan** did, and **Jesus** knew that Judas would give into **Satan**. The Old Testament had <u>predicted</u> this in Psalm 41:9 where it says: "Even My close friend, on whom I relied, who shared My table, has turned against Me" (*CJB*).

Now onward to our 3<sup>rd</sup> and final text, Mark 14:22-25:

# Day 25–Institution of the Lord's Supper:

14:22 While they were eating, He took some bread, and after making a blessing, He broke it, and gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is My body." 23 And when He had taken a cup [of wine] and blessed it, He gave it to them, and they all drank from it. 24 And He said to them, "This is My blood of the covenant [My last will & testament], which is poured out for many. 25 Truly I say to you, I will never again drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the Kingdom of God" [after My death, when all sin is forgiven and I am resurrected].

Paul's words from 1 Corinthians 10:16 are *essential* as a <u>connection</u> to **Christ**'s words in *Mark*:

"Is the cup...<mark>of wine</mark>]...not a communion of the <u>blood</u> of Christ? Is the <u>bread</u>... not a communion of the <u>body</u> of Christ?"

Crucial point: The Lord's Supper is the <u>New Testament</u> Passover! How?
